Jaycees of the Quad Cities' Bar-B-QC Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All proceeds will benefit the Jaycees of the Quad Cities and the local non-profits they support. The Jaycees of the Quad Cities' KCBS Member number is 109762. The BBQ cook-off will be held rain or shine.
- 2. All entries must be received by August 1st, 2023.
- 3. The BBQ cook-off is a family friendly event and intended as a good-natured competition.
- 4. A maximum of 18 competitors will be allowed to compete.
- 5. You will be required to follow Scott County Health department regulations, Health department requirements will be included with the entry fee.
- 6. People's Choice participants will need to cook a 5-6lb pork butt to be served by 5:30pm on Saturday, September 23rd. The pork butts have been donated by Tyson.
- a. Competing in the People's Choice will be a team requirement.
- b. Since this event is a fundraiser, you will serve individuals who provide you with a ticket in a provided 2-3oz cup. For each ticket you will serve 2-3oz of pulled pork.
- c. Each ticket you get will count as a vote, please make sure you save the tickets.
- d. We will tally the tickets at 9pm on Saturday, September 24th. Winner will be announced on Sunday along with the other categories.
- e. If you want to make sides for People's Choice, you can earn additional tickets for handing those samples. Sides are not required, and the type of side is your choice.
- 7. Electricity will be provided for everyone.
- 8. A volunteer will be onsite on Friday, September 22nd from 1-7pm for early arrivals.
- 9. There will be security there from 11pm 6am on both Friday and Saturday.
- 10. Entry-fee is nonrefundable.

Categories

- 1. There will be 4 judged categories this year: Chicken, pork ribs, pork butt, and People's Choice pork butt.
- 2. You will be judged in each category (besides People's Choice) by KCBS Backyard BBQ rules and regulations. KCBS BBQ standards will be followed.

Cooking Area

- 1. Each competitor will be given a 14' X 16' space, first come, first served on cooking locations. All cooking facilities, rigs must fit within your team's contest space. Additional parking for vehicles will be available outside the contest area. You will be stationed on a cemented area. Tent staking will not be an option. Please place cardboard or grill mats under your grills in order to mitigate spills and grease.
- 2. Competitors are responsible for supplying their own grill, cooking equipment, tables and gloves, ice, and a handwashing station. The health department will be around to inspect your area.
- 3. No open burning is allowed. Each competitor must have a grill that contains fire, coals, or wood, and is raised off the ground.
- 4. BBQ entries must be cooked on-site and according to the KCBS Sanctioned Stand Alone Backyard BBQ Contest rules and regulations.

- 5. Jaycees of the Quad Cities will not be held responsible for theft or damage to equipment, or bodily injury of any kind.
- 6. The event organizer reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations as the situation warrants. Decisions of the event organizer are final.

VIP Judging Awards

- 1. First through fifth place awards will be chosen based on the scoring of the KCBS judges.
- 2. Trophies will be provided for 1st through 3rd place in each category.
- 3. There will be a trophy and a purse for the Grand Champion (\$500) and Grand Champion Reserve (\$300).
- 4. In total \$7,500 purse (which includes People's Choice). Please note, if we have LESS than 13 competitors, we will not be giving out 4th and 5th place in chicken, pork, or ribs:

- 6. You must be able to enter and cook all 4 categories using the space provided. Pork butts will be provided for the People's Choice event by Tyson!
- 7. Judging will begin at 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 24th.
- 8. Turn in times: Chicken 12:00pm, Pork ribs, 12:30pm, and pork at 1:00pm. Awards ceremony at 2:30pm-3:30pm outside the Judge's tent.
- 9. Cook's meeting is at 11:00am on Saturday, September 23rd.
- 10. All entries (besides People's Choice) will be judged via KCBS sanctioned event standards.
